RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE OSCE/ODIHR Conference, Warsaw, Poland, 24 Sept-05 October 2012

The European Network Against Racism (ENAR) calls on Participating States to:

- 1. Ensure full compliance with existing Equality Legislation in the OSCE Region and the EU.
- 2. Ensure the adoption of the proposed Horizontal Equality Directive of the EU, filling the existing gaps in available anti-discrimination law. Germany is in the forefront of countries obstructing the adoption of this Directive.
- 3. Ensure that the Victim's Package provide needed support to victims of hate crime, regardless of legal status.
- 4. Adopt a positive approach to migration in negotiations on migration law and policy, and enhance the cooperation of States to improve integration policies.
- 5. Ensure that the Asylum Policies in Participating States including the Common European Asylum System (CEAS) are truly fair and effective, and that the human rights of asylum seekers and refugees are always respected.
- 6. Strengthen Social Institutions such as the Social Pillar of the Europe 2020 strategy.
- 7. Strengthen the process of the European Framework for National Roma Integration Strategies to achieve real policy and practical results.
- 8. Ensure that future multiannual financial frameworks allocate sufficient funds to programmes that foster equality, social inclusion and fundamental rights.
