Research Paper – Writing Guidelines

1. Structure of a Research Paper:

- Headline, capital letters, **bold**, 12;
- Author's (Co-author's) Name and Surname, **bold**, 12;
- Abstract, written in Macedonian and English, i.e. Albanian and English (each abstract should not contain more than 250 words);
- Key words, 3-5 key words (NOT included in the headline, title);
- Introduction;
- Material and Methods;
- Results;
- Conclusion (concluding remarks);
- List of references;

2. Manuscript Requirements

The Manuscript should be prepared in accordance with the following guidelines: the manuscript should be written in Macedonian, Albanian or English language in MS Word, A4 Format, using Arial with Macedonian language support for Cyrillic script, Albanian language support for Roman/Latin script and with English language support for Roman/Latin script, with "12" font, spacing (1, 5 lines), Justify and margins: top, bottom, left and right (2, 54 cm) and every page should be numbered.
