MEETING VENUE

TRAVEL

Unless previously agreed with the organizers, participants are responsible for making their own travel arrangements (including transfers, if travelling by plane).

For participants travelling by car, parking space in a hotel garage is available and each participant is responsible for making the corresponding arrangements directly with the hotel upon check in.

REGISTRATION

Each participant is requested to **register online** before the **deadline of 15 October 2019** through the link accessible via URL or QR code (for your mobile phone).

To register for this event, please use the accounts already created for previous OSCE events. The account is linked to the e-mail used for creation and in case password has been forgotten, you can reset it easily.

One single person may register different participants, with the use of the same password and email address.

Please follow during the registration process the button "next" in the lower right hand corner until completed. Properly filled registration will be submitted by using the "submit" button in the lower right hand corner after which you will get information "Your data has been successfully received. Confirmation on registration/participation will be sent at a later stage."

Please note, that the log-in as well password created for this event will enable participants to also register via "events.osce.org" for other OSCE events in the future. It will therefore be important to enter complete and accurate data into the database and to keep this personal password for any future use.



Revisions: until or after the registration deadline, registered participants may use their password to access their on-line registration form at any time, in view of updating a number of 'non-compulsory', additional fields (i.e. date of arrival, accommodation, participation to reception), until and at latest by Tuesday, 22 October 2019.
