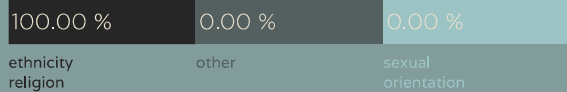

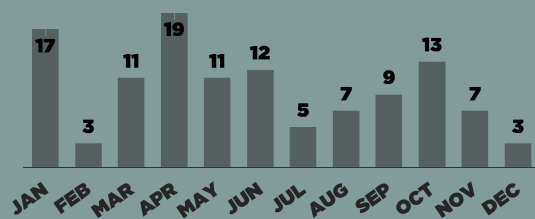

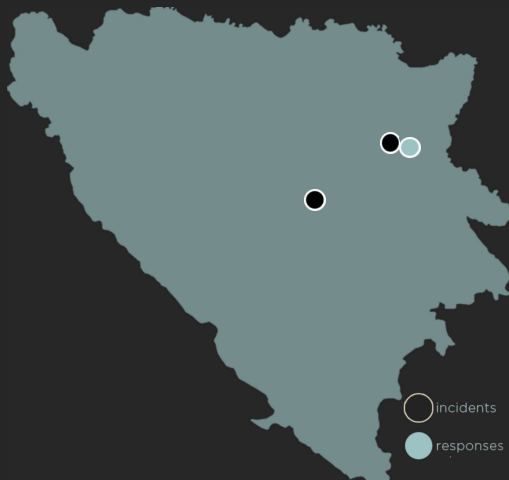

In December, the OSCE Mission to BiH, in co-operation with Prnjavor City Authorities, hosted a roundtable uniting the Mayor, City Assembly Speaker and Administration, local police, civil society, and vulnerable groups to explore the OSCE's community cohesion methodology.
