

## **CALL FOR APPLICATION:**

The Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE) Mission in Kosovo is pleased to invite you to apply for the **Mock Court Reporting** training which will take place on 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> November 2024 in Basic Court Prishtinë/Priština.

The training will be followed by a concluding workshop which will take place on *15<sup>th</sup> November 2024*, at *Hotel Hotel Sirius*, in Prishtinë/Priština.

The aim of this interactive exercise is to provide young and aspiring journalists from all communities in Kosovo and representatives of justice institutions with first-hand experience in court reporting. Judges, prosecutors, and spokespersons of courts will be guided on how to provide information to journalists without compromising issues of privacy or jeopardizing court proceedings. Conversely, young aspiring journalists and law students from all over Kosovo will be instructed on best practices for gathering information and communicating with justice officials and vice versa. The concluding workshop on 15<sup>th</sup> November will provide a platform to discuss lessons learned and derive conclusions and recommendations.

We invite students, from all communities, in the journalism department and aspiring journalists, as well as law students from all over Kosovo to apply.

Transport to the Justice Palace and back is covered. The training will be held in Albanian language and translation in Serbian language will be provided.
