Principal motivation behind terroristic movements and actions

Primary aim:

Taking direct strike in order to:

- > "punish", set fear and uncertainity, avenge
- demonstrate abilities to hit, power, presence
- > paralize vital functions of the society, economy

Secondary aim:

Supporting terroristic organisations, actions by means of:

- > getting persons, weapons to the action field ("Trojan Horse Effect")
- > financing preparation and training of persons, providingweapons and

etc.

Potential involvement of inland navigation relating terroristic actions

Inland navigation may appear as:

- > a direct target to be hit (infrastructure, passenger ships and etc.)
- > a "Trojan Horse" (containers, crew members, passengers and etc.)
- > a weapon (ships carrying dangerous goods and etc.)

Some of the factors that can impact the terrorism-related risk

Factors that should mitigate the risk:

- effective implementation of the EU Strategy for the Danube Region
- development of RIS along the Danube
- proper education and training of the personnel operating ships and infrastructure
- development of the international co-operation in field of security of the navigation

Factors that might enlarge the risk:

- > development of containerisation along the Danube
- > development of traffic of cruise ships, dangerous goods
- > bad waterway conditions resulting in interruptions of the transport flow



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
