Background

Criminals misuse technology in all stages of human trafficking to maintain anonymity, exploit victims, and expand their reach, including livestreaming abuse and committing online scams. The last couple of years have witnessed the rapid development of Artificial Intelligence. Since many AI tools can replicate human behavior, it is important to explore its risks for the crime of human trafficking.

At the same time, **significant legislative advancements** across the OSCE region and beyond in recent years aimed at combating technologyfacilitated human trafficking. But more needs to be done.

Legislators must adapt to these evolving trends and create strong frameworks to counter technology misuse. This event will bring together stakeholders to discuss legislative strategies and collaborative efforts to fight tech-facilitated human trafficking.
