Malta's legal framework is in place with regard to the prohibition of the use, production, storage, transfer and destruction of antipersonnel landmines through the National Interest Enabling Powers Act, (Chap. 365) and the Military Equipment (Export Control) Regulations. No moratorium was introduced.

Malta does not produce, use, stock or transfer anti-personnel landmines. There are no known mined areas within Maltese territory and no such assistance is required.
