DECISION No. 533 RENAMING THE OSCE MISSION TO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA

The Permanent Council,

Recalling Permanent Council Decisions Nos. 401 and 402 of 11 January 2001 concerning the establishment of the OSCE Mission to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, 444 of 15 November 2001 on the establishment of the Office in Podgorica, 451 of 21 December 2001 and 516 of 12 December 2002, extending the Mission's mandate,

Noting that following the adoption and promulgation of the Constitutional Charter of the state union of Serbia and Montenegro by the Assembly of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia on 4 February 2003, as previously adopted by the National Assembly of the Republic of Serbia on 27 January 2003, and by the Assembly of the Republic of Montenegro on 29 January 2003, the name of the participating State has been changed to "Serbia and Montenegro",

Decides to rename the "OSCE Mission to the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia" the "OSCE Mission to Serbia and Montenegro", effective as of today.
