## **DECISION No. 94**

The Permanent Council

Decides that the term "partners for co-operation" will henceforth be used to refer to Japan and the Republic of Korea, and the term "Mediterranean partners for co-operation" to Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Morocco and Tunisia. These changes in name do not alter the specific relationships between these States and the OSCE set out in previous OSCE decisions; and

Requests the Chairman-in-Office to bring the present decision to the attention of the above-mentioned States.
