Chairman's Statement

With respect to the decision taken by the Permanent Council on 15 December 1994 on the extension of the mandate of the CSCE Mission to Latvia, the Chairman-in-Office expresses his satisfaction with the Mission's work, in particular its important contribution to the adoption of the citizenship law by the Latvian Parliament, after having taken into account recommendations by the relevant international institutions, including the CSCE High Commissioner on National Minorities.

He is convinced that the successful role of the Mission is facilitated by the effective support of the Latvian authorities as well as by the Mission's co-operation with the High Commissioner on National Minorities, the Council of Europe and the United Nations.

The Chairman-in-Office expresses the continuous political support of the CSCE for the Mission's efforts in fulfilling its advisory role aimed at full and successful implementation of its tasks.
