Due to the ongoing armed aggression of Russia and significant contamination of the territory of Ukraine with mines and explosive remnants of war, Ukraine has a significant need to equip demining units with appropriate means.

The lists of necessary technical means and equipment for demining provided by the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine and the State Emergency Service of Ukraine are attached.

6. Does your country have the capacity to assist others related to this Protocol? If so, please describe.

Ukraine is currently unable to assist others in implementation of the protocol requirements due to the fact that all efforts of Ukraine are aimed at repelling the aggression of the Russian Federation and clearing de-occupied territories from mines and explosive residues of war.

9. *Does your country have any specific measures in place to provide assistance to victims?*

Pursuant to paragraph 35 of the Oslo Action Plan on the Implementation of the Ottawa Convention, the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine, as the Secretariat of the National Mine Action Authority (the Secretariat) launched a centralized interactive database of incidents involving mines and explosive remnants of war, as well as persons affected by them.

The interactive database of the Secretariat has been operating since September 2022 and as of 1 January 2024 contains verified data on 887 civilians who were affected by mine explosions and explosive remnants of war, and 193 cases of violations by the Russian Federation of the laws and customs of war related to the use of anti-personnel mines by the aggressor state against the civilian population on the territory of Ukraine.

On the basis of information obtained from the database of the Secretariat of the National Mine Action Authority, 54 persons affected by mine-explosive injuries received financial assistance, medicines, surgical treatment, rehabilitation equipment, computer equipment for remote work and employment at a total cost in UAH 1,105,587.

10. *Does your country require assistance in mine clearance, stockpile destruction, mine awareness and/or victim assistance? If so, please describe.*

As of the beginning of 2024, Ukraine is the most mined country in the world. According to the results of the latest analysis of the survey, the territory of Ukraine with an area of 156,000 square kilometres is potentially contaminated with explosive objects, of which 14,000 square kilometres are water areas (taking into account occupied territories and territories where measures are taken to repel aggression).

The number of civilian casualties from Russian mines and explosive remnants of war in Ukraine is increasing every day. The biggest danger for the population is the pollution of the de-occupied territories by Russian mines. 75% of cases are mine incidents. Today, the Kharkiv, Mykolaiv and Kherson regions remain the most polluted, where more than 60% of all incidents took place.

In the context of providing international assistance in demining, in June 2023, Ukraine and Lithuania launched an initiative to form a Coalition of Demining Capabilities with the aim of training and equipping 10 battalions and 3 separate companies of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine for demining (humanitarian demining) of the de-occupied territories of Ukraine.

In May 2023, the project of international technical assistance from the US Government to Ukraine for the destruction of conventional weapons was registered.

The beneficiaries of the project are the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine and the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine. The estimated cost of the project amounted to more than 70 million US dollars. The project envisages the establishment and operation of a school in Ukraine, on the territory of which up to 100 specialists in humanitarian demining per year will be able to train according to the international IMAS standards.

In addition, the National Mine Action Authority, provides international donors with information on verified cases of civilians who have suffered as a result of mine explosions and explosive remnants of war.

Thus, the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine continues its work on attracting international assistance to units for demining (humanitarian demining) of the de-occupied territories of Ukraine, as well as civilians affected by mine-explosive injuries.

International support to the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine in the above areas will be sincerely welcomed. The lists of necessary technical means and equipment for demining provided by the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine and the State Emergency Service of Ukraine are attached.

11. Does your country have the capacity to assist others in mine action? If so, please describe.

Ukraine is currently unable to assist others in the implementation of the Convention requirements, this is due to the fact that all the efforts of Ukraine are aimed at repelling the aggression of the Russian Federation and clearing from mines and explosive residues of war of de-occupied territories.

OSCE QUESTIONNAIRE ON EXPLOSIVE REMNANTS OF WAR

1. Has your country notified the Depository of its consent to be bound by the 2003 CCW Protocol V on Explosive Remnants of War (ERW) once it enters into force? Is your country considering doing so?

2. If yes, at what stage is the process?

In 2004, Ukraine adopted Protocol V on Explosive Remnants of War.

3. Would your country be interested in receiving assistance in clearing or otherwise minimizing the risks and effects of ERW? If so, please describe.

As of the beginning of 2024, Ukraine is the most mined country in the world. According to the results of the latest analysis of the survey, the territory of Ukraine with an area of 156,000 square meters is potentially contaminated with explosive objects. km, of which 14,000 sq. km are water areas (taking into account occupied territories and territories where measures are taken to repel aggression).

The number of civilian casualties from Russian explosive remnants of war (ERW) in Ukraine is increasing every day. The pollution of the de-occupied

territories by Russian air defense poses a great danger to the population. 25% of cases are precisely incidents with ERW. Kharkiv, Mykolaiv, and Kherson regions remain the most polluted today, where the majority of incidents occur.

In the context of providing international assistance in clearing Ukraine of ERW, in June 2023, Ukraine and Lithuania launched an initiative to form a Coalition of Demining Capabilities with the aim of training and equipping 10 battalions and 3 separate companies of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine for demining (humanitarian demining) of the occupied territories of Ukraine. The relevant units were formed to implement the decision of the Minister of Defense of Ukraine dated 22 March 2023.

In May 2023, the project of international technical assistance from the US Government to Ukraine for the destruction of conventional weapons was registered. The beneficiaries of the project were the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine and the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine. The estimated cost of the project amounted to more than 70 million dollars. USA. The MTD project envisages the creation and operation of a school in Ukraine, on the territory of which up to 100 specialists in humanitarian demining per year will be able to train according to the international standards of IMAS mine action. In this context, an increase in the international community's support to the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine in the above areas will be sincerely welcomed.

The lists of necessary technical means and equipment for demining provided by the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine and the State Emergency Service of Ukraine are attached.

4. Does your country have the capacity to assist others in clearing and minimizing the risks and effects of ERW? If so, please describe.

Ukraine is currently unable to assist others in implementation of the Protocol V requirements due to the fact that all the efforts of Ukraine are aimed at repelling the aggression of the Russian Federation and clearing from mines and explosive remnants of war of de-occupied territories.

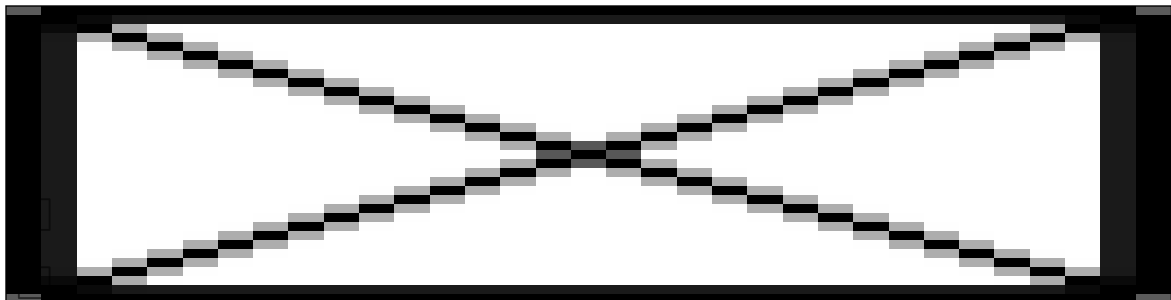

INFORMATION TO THE ARMED FORCES:

In 2023, the work was continued to share information among the personnel of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and other ministries and departments of the Security and Defense Forces about the principles and requirements of Protocol II, as amended on May 3, 1996. The principles of the Protocol studies as a separate issue for specialist engineering troops inspecialized education and during engineering training of all personnel of the Armed Forcesof Ukraine. References to the Convention are included in the manuals and guidelines for engineering units of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

INFORMATION TO THE CIVILIAN POPULATION:

The Ministry of Defense of Ukraine through periodicals, visual aids and recommendations, are working with the civilian population to provide materials for the main provisions of Protocol II with amended.

Specialists of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine are constantly working with the civilian population to inform about the risks associated with explosive remnants of war (MRE activities). These apply visual aids and recommendations for education of the civilian population inmatters of mine safety, marking, control and monitoring of territory, contaminated by explosive remnants of war.

In order to inform the civilian population, an interactivemap of areas contaminated with mines and ERW has been created and operated.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

The Ministry of Defense of Ukraine are taking measures to comply with the technical requirements of Protocol II, as amended. By order of the Minister of Defense of Ukraine, anti-personnel mines that do not meet the requirements of the Technical Annex to Protocol II are disarmed by the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

The relevant regulations were developed and submitted on the use of engineering ammunition of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

New advanced engineering ammunition for the Armed Forces of Ukraine are projected with all the requirements of Protocol II.

A constant monitoring of the use of engineering and other ammunition during the course of repelling the full-scale armed aggression of the Russian Federation in order to prevent violations of Protocol II.

Locations of minefields or individual mines are registered in the forms of engineering obstacles, which are worked out in 3 copies:

1st in the military unit that installed the minefields or that contains them;

2nd in the headquarters of the operational command (operational and tactical group) to which is transferred (belongs) to operational subordination the military unit which installed the minefield (individual mines);

3rd in the Command of the Support Forces of the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

The form indicates the location of minefields, individual mines with reference to at least two landmarks that are difficult to destroy and indicating their coordinates, as well as complete information on types, quantity, method of installation, type of detonators, date and time of installation, the presence of elements and other relevant information.

The place of installation of remotely-installed minefields (mines) is provided to be indicated by the coordinates of the starting points (angular) with the subsequent clarification and marking. The total number and type of mines, date and time of installation and time of self-liquidation are registered.

To ensure the visibility and recognition of the established minefields by the civilian population, the use of special signs recommended by the Technical Annex is envisaged.

INTERNATIONAL TECHNICAL INFORMATION EXCHANGE:

Ukraine is conducting measures to attract international technical assistance for demining of de-occupied territories, equipping government mine countermeasure operators and training demining specialists.

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION ON MINE CLEARANCE:

In order to speed up the implementation of demining measures, the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine is involved the international non-governmental organizations: The HALO Trust, the Representation of the Danish Refugee Council in Ukraine, the Swiss Mine Action Fund, the Mine Advisory Group in Ukraine, Norwegian Peoples Aid in Ukraine, Danish Church Aid in Ukraine. Regarding the implementation of the Plan for humanitarian demining in Ukraine, within the framework of the assistance of the US State Department, together with representatives of the TetraTech company, measures are being taken to form a temporary training center for demining specialists and to implement joint project activities in Ukraine to provide assistance in the field mine action.

As part of the involvement of material and technical assistance, the Center for Mine Action of the State Special Service of Transport, from the Embassy of Ukraine in the Kingdom of Sweden and the Embassy of Ukraine in the Republic of Croatia, received a search equipment, protection equipment, equipment for cordon of mine\UXO contaminated areas and equipment for underwater demining.

TECHNICAL COOPERATION AND ASSISTANCE:

In accordance with the 2023 Plan for humanitarian demining of the de-occupied territories of Ukraine, international non-governmental organizations carried out demining activities: Among the international non-governmental organizations involved in humanitarian demining are: The HALO Trust, Danish Refugee Council, Fondation Suisse de deminage. Since the beginning of the large-scale armed aggression of the Russian Federation (February 24, 2022), the above-mentioned non-governmental organizations have conducted a non-technical survey of 2250 areas with a total area of 29,674 hectares and a technical survey of 182 areas with a total area of 2555 hectares, cleared 234 hectares of territories, identified 7103 unexploded ordnances, during NTS 18 000 sq. km indicated as out of suspicion.

In order to implement Action 35 of Oslo Action Plan Ministry of Defence of Ukraine as the National Mine Action Authority Secretariat established a centralised interactive database on landmine and explosive remnants of war accidents and victims. Thanks to the National Mine Action Authority Secretariat database information sharing 54 survivors with post-explosion traumas managed to receive the assistance in cash, medicines, rehabilitation equipment, surgery, computer hard & software required for remote empowerment and learning. Total cost of such assistance so far reached 1 105 587,00 Ukrainian hryvnia.

Form I Cooperation and assistance

On June 2023 Ukraine and the Republic of Lithuania established Demining Capability Coalition to train and equip 10 battalions and 3 separated companies of Ministry of Defence of Ukraine assigned for the purposes of demining (humanitarian demining) of the newly liberated areas of Ukraine. Those units were formed following the relevant Decision of the Minister of Defense of Ukraine from 22nd March 2023.

On May 2023 the US Government International Technical Assistance Project was registered on Conventional Weapons Destruction Support for Ukraine (CWDSU). Beneficiaries of the project include Ministry of Defence of Ukraine and Ministry of Interior of Ukraine. Total cost of the project is so far 70 mln. US Dollars. The ITA project aims the foundation and further support for Ukrainian school for the purposes of training not less than 100 humanitarian deminers annually according to IMAS standards.
