






Alps: 200 000 km2 8 countries Austria: 63 % of the landscape are Alps



- The longer the distances of transports the more obstacles you have to overcome
- Natural barriers (costs):
 - physical barriers (mountains, rivers, seas)
 - time zones
 - climatic differences

- Bureaucratic obstacles
- e.g. abnormal transport loads surpassing the allowed limits
- lack of transparency of the licensing procedures
- bribe
- loss of time at border

- Steps towards future 1:
- upgrading of traffic systems by improve accessibility (by strategic corridors and upgraded minor roads)
- improve attractiveness of transport modes (road, rail, ship, aircraft)
- reduction of formalities for crossing boarders (tariffs of customs, cabotage, informal financial hurdles)
- harmonisation of (national) regulations: technical issues, transport prohibitions (eg tunnels), obligatory use of transport modes (rail), track gauge (rail), electric current, gross vehicle weight)
- implementation of international agreements (dangerous goods)

- Steps towards future 2:
- safe parking places (protection against organized crime/theft)
- services for drivers: motorway restaurants / service areas with public toilets/lavatories, banks, hotels
- petrol stations, reparatur facilities, car mechanic services
