The Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE) Mission in Kosovo invites **women from all communities** who are passionate about improving security, fostering dialogue, and collaborating with **Women's Security Networks** to apply for a **training on public dialogue facilitation**, organized in co-operation with the **Nansen Center for Peace and Dialogue**.

Dates: from 7 to 11 April 2025, 09:00-17:00 hrs. daily

Location: Hotel Sharri, Prevalle/Prevalac, Prizren region

Format: In-person

Language: Simultaneous translation will be provided in **English, Albanian, and Serbian languages**

Transportation: Provided or reimbursed

Accommodation: Provided, if needed

About the Training:

Since 2008, the OSCE Mission in Kosovo has supported the development of formal and informal **Women's Security Networks** across Kosovo. These networks bring together women from diverse communities and professional backgrounds to exchange information, foster dialogue, and promote safety and inclusion.

This training, delivered by expert trainers from the **Nansen Center for Peace and Dialogue**, a leading institution in training and education on dialogue to promote peace and reconciliation in Norway, will equip participants with the skills to **organize and lead inclusive, constructive public dialogues** on sensitive or complex community issues. It covers the principles of creating safe spaces where diverse voices can share their perspectives openly, fostering trust, understanding, and stronger community connections. Through practical exercises, participants will learn how to plan, structure, and guide public dialogues, helping to counter polarization, empower non-majority voices, and support inclusive decision-making. This training is suitable for community leaders, activists, and anyone committed to promoting meaningful, democratic dialogue in their local community.

The training by one of the world's recognised leaders in dialogue facilitation and mediation is ideal for **community leaders, activists, journalists, women committed to promoting meaningful, democratic dialogue** in their communities. The participants will receive a certificate.

Eligibility Criteria:

Women from all communities are welcome to apply, provided they meet the following criteria:

- **18 years or older** at the time of application
- **Reside in Kosovo**
- **Proficient in** Albanian or Serbian languages
- Demonstrates a full commitment to attend and actively participate in the entire training program. Demonstrates a strong interest in facilitating public dialogues and leveraging these skills to empower and engage their communities.

- **Willingness to collaborate** with diverse women from Women's Security Networks

Selection Criteria:

Participants will be selected based on the following considerations:

- **Motivation and commitment** to apply the acquired skills in their communities
- **Diversity of representation** to ensure a broad range of perspectives from different communities, geographic, and professional backgrounds
- **Active involvement** in community initiatives or leadership roles
- **Willingness to engage in collaborative, multicultural dialogue**
